SETTING UP YOUR ROUTER FOLLOW THESE STEPS

1. Connect the router to your computer via network cable (plug into any LAN port) or WiFi.



- 2. Open any browser & key in **192.168.1.1** or *linksyssmartwifi.com* in the address bar, then hit *Enter*.
- 3. When the below screen appears, key in *admin* (default password) & click *Sign In*.
