WIFI MANUAL Setting up your router

Follow these steps:-

1. Connect your computer to an available LAN port (1/2/3/4) on the TP-LINK C1200. Your computer will automatically obtain an IP address in the 192.168.x.1 range.

- 2. Open a web browser and type http://192.168.0.1 in the Address Bar.
- 3. When the login window appears, enter *Username* and *Password* where passwords are case sensitive. *Username: admin / Password: TIME (last 4 MAC address)*
- 4. Check the **Software Version** and make sure it is the latest. If is not, please upgrade to the latest version.
